Kit A – Drawing and Watercolor Painting

- (Gouache) Paint Set [Watercolor Pan Set by Artist's Loft™ Necessities™](#)
- Round Royal Golden Talon [WC Brush Set of 5](#) OR similar size #8 brush
- 9x12 Canson fold over XL Series Watercolor Pad (Amazon, Michaels, Joann)
- Jar for water (I supply these for face-to-face lessons)
- #2 school pencil or HB drawing pencil
- Pink pearl eraser
- Fine tip Sharpie marker (extra fine tip in addition is optional)
- White wax crayon



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Kit B – Drawing with Colored Pencil Class

- [Amazon Basics Premium Colored Pencils](#), Soft Core, 24 Count or Prisma Pencil set (larger kit optional)
- 9x12 Bristol Board Pad SMOOTH surface
- #2 school pencil or HB drawing pencil
- Pink pearl eraser

Kit C – Drawing with Oil Pastel

- Set if basic colors student grade oil pastels. **I recommend [Pentel Arts Oil Pastels](#) or [SAKURA Cray-Pas Expressionist Oil Pastels](#).** With many art supplies, the price difference is determined by the amount of color pigment and the quality of the binder. Color pigment is almost self-explanatory, but this is why expensive paint or oil pastels will transfer to the paper with a richer, deeper, even brighter look. You're literally seeing more color on the paper. Binder, on the other hand, is what holds the color pigment together so that it can be formed into a shape. When oil pastels use more of a wax binder (to save money) they will behave more like crayons and will not blend as smoothly as an oil pastel should.
- 9x12 Bristol Board Pad SMOOTH surface
- #2 school pencil or HB drawing pencil
- Pink pearl eraser
- Black fine tip Sharpie marker (extra fine time in addition is optional)
